What happens next?

Once NHS England has reviewed all stakeholder feedback, if there are potential impacts that need further engagement, the policy will go out to a formal public consultation. If wider consultation does take place you, along with other stakeholders, will be welcome to comment on the proposal again.

Public Consultation on Puberty Suppressing Hormones for Children and Young People with Gender Incongruence/Dysphoria

On a separate but related matter, following stakeholder testing, NHS England is now inviting feedback via a formal 90 day public consultation on a new draft interim clinical policy on the use of puberty supressing hormones in children and adolescents who have gender incongruence or gender dysphoria. A final decision on the clinical policy following public consultation will be made by NHS England following a recommendation from the Clinical Priorities Advisory Group (CPAG).
